# THE FLIGHT DRIVING MANUAL

## Gin Flight \$25

### 1. Original Spirit Co. Somerville

A strong, aromatic foundation of organic juniper berries and Australian grown coriander seeds is complemented by a blend of seven traditional and native botanicals. Vibrant hints of fruit and citrus bring the palate to life.

Locally made on the Peninsula in Somerville.

### 2. East London Liquor, U.K

This London Dry Gin is distilled using the finest 100% British wheat spirit both vapour and direct infused with fresh lemon & grapefruit peel, coriander, angelica root, juniper berries, cubeb berries and cardamom. The bright, fresh flavours of the citrus and juniper give way to the spiciness of the cubeb berries and cardamom, making this an excellent gin & tonic spirit, topped off a slice of pink grapefruit.

### 3. Tanqueray Rangpur, U.K

The rare Rangpur lime is an ingenious choice to bring a distinct and bold flavour to Tanqueray Rangpur. With the zestiness of lime and the juiciness of mandarin orange, this gin is the best kept secret of the British-Indian tradition. Best enjoyed with premium tonic water, a slice of lime & mandarin.

### 4. Malfy con Limone, Italy

Malfy Gin Con Limone marries the finest Italian coastal lemons with our family's unique gin recipe to create a one-of-a kind spirit. Distilled with classic Italian Juniper and Sfusato lemon peels from the Amalfi Coast - it has delightful citrus and juniper on the nose with a complex flavour of anise, citrus and coriander.

## Pink Gin Flight \$25

### 1. Cotswolds Gin, Cotswolds U.K.

From the Cotswolds, U.K. on the nose there is fresh notes of grapefruit and perfumed lavender from the Cotswolds. The grapefruit continues on the palate with a touch of coriander seed. It's a very delicate gin, hence why it's paired with a more delicate fruit such as grapefruit and strawberry.

### 2. Gin Lane 'Victoria' Pink, U.K.

The tradition of blending gin with bitters was first created by the British Royal Navy to balance out sweet and dry gins...and supposedly to help cure sea sickness. They've created a well-balanced gin with juniper still at the forefront but with a harmonious balance of herbal and spiced bitters.

### 3. Malfy con Arancia, Italy

Malfy Con Arancia's key botanical additions are Blood Orange peels sourced from Sicily. The Blood Orange peels are steeped in alcohol and pressed in a basket press. The infusion is then blended with juniper and other botanicals before being distilled in a stainless steel vacuum still.

### 4. Blood Orange & Yuzu Ginfusion, Somerville

Hailing from Somerville, this 'ginfusion' is crafted from a blend of Aussie Blood Oranges & exotic Japanese Yuzu, this rich and unique medley of citrus is sure to impress.

Forget the tonic, just add ice.

# THE FLIGHT DRIVING MANUAL

## Rum Flight \$30

### 1. 2003 Plantation Trinidad Double Age

A 2003 vintage rum, distilled at Angostura in Trinidad and blended by brand owner Cognac Ferrand, Plantation Trinidad is spicy and chocolatey with a pleasingly dry finish. Pineapple chunks, golden syrup and grassy sugar cane. Clove and cardamom spice.

### 2. Jimmy Rum Barbados, Dromana

For this premium rum, Jimmy carefully selected and blended three, five and eight year old aged rums sourced from the famous Foursquare Rum Distillery in Barbados. This smooth and complex rum is created to be enjoyed neat or over ice; sip, savour and enjoy these complex flavours. Seriously smooth, great tropical fruit notes.

### 3. Admiral Rodney HMS Royal Oak, St Lucia

Admiral Rodney Royal Oak, the original Admiral Rodney blend, contains 7-12 year old Coffey still rum that has been aged exclusively in previously used Bourbon casks and blended to perfection. Bright amber colour with a nose of prunes, raisin fruit, toasty oak and tropical spiced. Intense mouth-feel of sweet sultana fruit, tobacco, and chocolate, with vanilla from the oak. Complex finish with sweet fruit, caramel, and spice.

### 4. Jimmy Rum Navy Strength, Dromana

Look Out! This is our Navy Strength Spirit. Bottled at higher ABV and designed for use in cocktails that require a spirit that can “hold its own” amongst other ingredients. While keeping our distinct “Silver” flavour profile this spirit is still smooth on the palette, but with a good bit of extra bight.

Navy Strength – Definition: **The alcoholic content of a spirit at which gunpowder will still ignite after being soaked in it. Also known as “Proof” strength or a spirit with a higher than 57.15%ABV**

## Whisky Flight \$30

### 1. Cotswolds Single Malt, U.K

The Cotswolds Single Malt Whisky is the first whisky ever distilled in the Cotswolds. On the nose there are notes of honey and butterscotch, and a hint of marzipan. On the palate Strong notes of tannin-rich malt, oils and dark sugar with lots of spice and caramelised Seville orange marmalade. The finish is long and resinous, with dark red fruits and a hint of treacle.

### 2. Overeem Port Cask, Tasmania

The Distillery’s Port Matured Whisky is aged in ex-port French-oak barrels. These hand-selected barrels have been cut down to 100 litre (quarter cask) capacity, which aids in producing an intense whisky of incredible character and flavour profile.

On the Nose there are intense aromatics, dark fruit chocolates, caramel, butterscotch, Turkish delight, crème brûlée, plum pudding & rum soaked raisins. The palate has a creamy texture, sweet and delicately spicy, fruitcake, caramel, liquorice & sweet malt. The finish is long with vanilla bean laced with spiced raisins.

### 3. Chiefs Son 900, Somerville

Locally made. Chief’s Son has a great collection, this is their Standard, but impressive whisky. The nose is filled with sweet fruit, sherry & roasted nuts, baked toffee & warm butterscotch, complex sweet leather & oak. On the palate, sherry, balanced oak & sweet barley, oily & complex with a late caramelised peat.

### 4. Highland Park Leif Eriksson Release Limited Edition, Scotland

This special edition Scotch was released to celebrate the first European to reach America over a thousand years ago. Wholly matured in American oak casks, both ex-bourbon and ex-sherry. The nose gives spicy and sweet aromas, floral, perfumed with vanilla fudge and oak. The palate continues with vanilla, juicy stone fruits with a ting of gentle woodsmoke. The finish is Demerara rum, nutmeg, spices and subtle wood smokiness again.
